Welcome to Eventide and our production of *Pippin*.

In Pippin, the role of The Leading Player does not have a defined gender. Ben Vereen originated the role in 1972, and Patina Miller portrayed her in the 2013 revival. Both Vereen and Miller won Tonys for their performances, making them the first two actors of different sexes to win a Tony for the same role.



With that in mind I decided to cast two Leading Players, one male and one female. Although the characters are similar, the yin and yang gives the show a deeper layer of discovery and point of view.

Our Pippin is the story of a traveling group of players who move from theater to theater looking for the perfect finale. They tell the coming of age story of Pippin, a fictional character, who is looking for extraordinary happiness and fulfillment. The players present him with an array of temptations to help him on his journey while always leading him to the perfect finale. As Pippin tries and fails, he discovers that looking for lifelong fulfillment in outside influences is not the answer. Happiness is found in the unextraordinary moments that happen every day.

Pippin is at times light and funny as well as dark and foreboding. The ETC company has delved into both sides of human nature in this production which will leave you thinking about your own life and how much we may be influenced by what others expect of us.

The late great Bob Fosse was the originator of the choreography. In our production we have paid homage to his work while investing our own twist as well.

Please enjoy the ETC production of Pippin. It will make you laugh, you may cry and you will certainly think. There is not much more theater can do for us. Thank you to my team, our cast and crew and to you, our audience. We have Magic to Do tonight so let's get to it.




